- Do you urgently need someone to speak to or simply need advice? The lobby will also be open with people available.
- We will begin operating a 'basics bank' of essential items (primarily toiletries) that we can distribute to those in need.

 We will start accepting donations for this immediately, stockpiling what we can, but we can only offer what we have!
- In so far as the situation allows we will also operate a free delivery service for pharmacy and other essential items to be taken to those vulnerable or self-isolating.
- While regular services and activities at The Free Church will be postponed indefinitely, we will meet outdoors on Easter Sunday morning (in the church car park) for a 10am service.
